Scrip rebate 100% to FRG/ISA - due to the success of the Legacy Marching Festival, the booster board voted to suspend the normal 75%/25% split of scrip rebates as a way to say “thank you”. For the months of November, December, and January 100% of the scrip rebate will be applied to the students FRG/ISA. All the more reason to get active in the scrip program! The fundraising committee wants to put together events that appeal to our band families and without your input we don't know which options to select. We also need additional volunteers, without more help we will not be able to organize fundraisers to help pay for the trip to Macy's.



March to Macy's begins!!!

Starting immediately – the fundraising committee will be evaluating and selecting additional fundraising opportunities to help band families work towards saving for next year's trip to New York City to march in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade. What an exciting opportunity for our students.

There are a few details you need to know.

- First – if a fundraiser is designated as a "March to Macy's" fundraiser then **100%** of the amount the student/family earns will be credited to the student. Since these fundraisers were not part of the 2010 budget, the band board has voted the 25% to the general band fund does not apply. Any funds earned will first be applied to the student's fundraising goal (FRG), then to their individual student activity (ISA).
- Second – if the student is a senior or not planning on taking the trip – they are still welcome to participate in the fundraiser and they will still receive 100% credit for their earnings. Same rules apply; the amount is first applied to any outstanding FRG, and then applied to their ISA.
- If you have not already returned your fundraising survey please do so ASAP. This is critical information for us to know which ideas will work best for our families!!!

We were immediately presented with two opportunities that fit well with the holiday season, **so here we go!**

Christmas tree coupon – We are teaming up with Tree Land Christmas Trees for a fundraiser. Tree Land has set up a website site us to print out a \$10.00 off coupon.

Three easy steps:

2. Print the coupon
3. Bring the emailed coupon with you to purchase your tree, wreath or garland at one of the 5 Denver area lots and Legacy Band will receive 30% of the profit as a fundraiser. (Nearest lot is at the Orchard Shopping Center)
